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RULES AND REGULATIONS

PLEASE READ CAREFULLY WITH YOUR CHILD!

WELCOME: Welcome to the summer camp program. Please review the handbook and read the rules with your children so that everyone will have a **SAFE** and a **FUN** summer camp experience. This program is **NOT** designed to be a babysitting service. Please, please, please, if your child has any special needs or takes any medication, fill out the information sheet appropriately. The more we know about your child helps our staff deal with any situation that may arise during camp hours.

CAMP ATTIRE: All campers **MUST** wear their playground t-shirt **EVERY DAY**. This includes all field trips as well as regular camp days. We ask that all campers wear sneakers or shoes. **NO FLIP FLOPS** due to safety reasons.

SIGNING IN AND OUT: All children must be signed in and out upon their arrival to and departure from the playground. Each child/parent must notify the playground counselors of their arrival to and departure from camp. All children must be signed out by an authorized adult. Children that are given permission to sign themselves in and out from camp **MUST** do so every time they arrive to camp and leave camp. This is only granted with parental permission. Any child/parent that does not abide by this policy will face suspension from the playground camp.

TRANSPORTATION: Transportation will be the responsibility of the parents or guardians. Buses will be provided for field trips and leave from the individual camp locations unless otherwise noted. Please check the bulletin boards daily at the camp locations. All school rules will be in effect for school bus transportation on field trips. **No exceptions.**

LATE FEES: A \$10.00 late fee will be applied for every 15 minutes or part of 15 minutes that you are late picking up your child/children. This also includes those children that are registered for the before & extended care programs. Abuse of this policy will result in suspension of your child from attending the camp.

NO EXCEPTIONS!! PLEASE BE PROMPT.

BEHAVIOR POLICY: Our summer camp program is designed to provide a supervised recreational program. Each child is expected to behave in a fashion suitable to the program. Cursing, fighting, stealing, bringing a weapon to camp, disrespecting the staff, abuse of equipment or facilities and disruptive behaviors will **NOT** be tolerated at the camps or on any field trips. **NO SMOKING** will be allowed. Any problems of this nature will result in suspension or expulsion from the camp with no refunds. All camp equipment is the property of the Branford Recreation Department. Malicious mishandling or abuse of equipment, etc. will require the parent/guardian to replace or repair any damages. This also applies to any buildings or facilities. Any child found to be non-compliant to these rules will be suspended and parents will be notified. No scooters, roller blades or skateboards are allowed at camp. Bikes **MUST** be put in designated areas. The skate park will **NOT** be available for campers who attend Hammer Field Playground Camp during the camp day.

RULES & REGULATIONS CONTINUED

LUNCHES: Campers must bring a lunch and a snack with them to camp every day. No glass bottles please. Pack extra drinks each day and especially on hot days. Water will be available to the campers.

RAIN SITE: ****All camps are to report to the Community House for a rain site.****
Rain sites are used if it is raining before camp starts. Please call 488-8304 and check to see if we are going to our regular camp sites or using our rain sites. There will be a message left on our machine. If it starts raining during the day, we cannot transport children to any rain sites. They will remain at their regular sites.

SUNSCREEN: Please apply sunscreen on your child/children daily. Sunscreen should be brought to camp each day. Counselors will remind children to reapply their sunscreen throughout the day.

FIELD TRIPS: Summer camp includes a number of field trips. Children are expected to behave appropriately and respectfully on all field trips. Camp t-shirts must be worn. No exceptions. All campers can attend a field trip without pre-registration except Lake Compounce.

**YOU CANNOT REGISTER FOR LAKE COMPOUNCE ON THE DAY OF THE TRIP.
NO EXCEPTIONS. SPACES ARE LIMITED.**

Pre-registration is required in the office and spaces are limited. Please check weekly for field trip information with your counselors. Dates and times may be different for each individual camp. Some trips include lunch. Spending money may also be brought on certain trips. It is the campers responsibility to hold on to their own money. Please encourage your child/children not to ask other campers for any money. Each camper will receive a calendar of events for their specific playground. Check departure location. A brief description of each field trip will be stated further in the handbook.

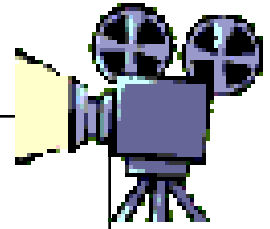
INFORMATION FORM CHANGES: Any changes made to your information forms must be done in the office. Our office staff will then let the appropriate camp counselors know the individual changes. This is extremely important for any changes made to the pick up list. No exceptions.

CAMP HOURS: Regular camp hours are from 9:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. Before care for those registered is from 8:00-9:00 a.m. After care for those registered is from 3-5:00 p.m.

HEAT POLICY: If the weather is hot and/or humid, and the conditions are not safe for the children to be outside in the heat, we may choose to close at Noon, close for the day or hold camp indoors. This will only be for extreme weather conditions. Please call 203-488-8304 for a message about any changes to the daily schedule.

ELECTRONICS: We recommend that all electronics including cell phones should remain at home. We are promoting socializing the "Old Fashion" way using verbal and social skills. If you and your child choose to bring electronics to camp they will be kept in the lunch bags or back packs and we **ARE NOT** responsible of lost, stolen or damaged items.

PLEASE MEET AT HAMMER FIELD

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING AND GO OVER THESE RULES WITH YOUR CHILD.

1. THERE ARE NO FLOTATION DEVICES OF ANY KIND ALLOWED IN THE PARK.
2. CHILDREN SHOULD WEAR THEIR BATHING SUITS IF THEY PLAN ON SWIMMING.
3. CHILDREN WILL ONLY BE ALLOWED TO SWIM IN THE POOL WATER PARK. NO ONE IS ALLOWED TO SWIM IN THE LAKE OR USE THE PADDLE BOATS.
4. ALL CHILDREN MUST WEAR SNEAKERS AND SOCKS. SANDALS ARE NOT ALLOWED AT ALL.
5. ALL CHILDREN MUST HAVE THEIR CAMP TEE-SHIRT ON AT ALL TIMES, INCLUDING WHEN THEY ARE IN THE WATER PARK. IT IS SUGGESTED THAT YOUR CHILD BRING THEIR EXTRA TEE-SHIRT WITH THEM SO THAT THEY CAN PUT ON A DRY SHIRT AFTER SWIMMING IN THE WATER PARK.
6. CHILDREN SHOULD NOT BRING ANYTHING OF VALUE WITH THEM, INCLUDING CAMERAS, GAME-BOYS, JEWELRY, CD PLAYERS AND WALKMANS, ETC.
7. THERE IS NO FOOD OR DRINK ALLOWED IN THE PARK. THE CHILDREN WILL BE PROVIDED WITH LUNCH, DRINKS, ICE-CREAM, ETC. DRINKS ARE FREE THROUGHOUT THE PARK.
8. CHILDREN CAN BRING SPENDING MONEY FOR GAMES, CANDY, GIFT STORE & FOOD.
9. CHILDREN MUST STAY WITH THEIR ASSIGNED COUNSELOR AT ALL TIMES.
10. PLEASE DROP YOUR CHILD OFF AT THE RECREATION DEPARTMENT BY 9:00 A.M. OR 8:00 A.M. IF YOU ARE REGISTERED FOR BEFORE CARE. PICK UP IS AT 5:30 P.M.

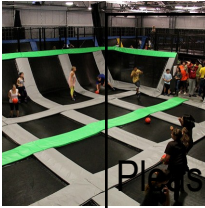

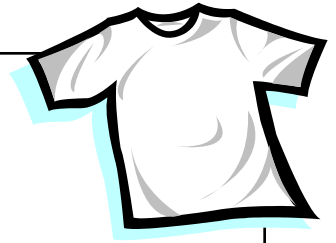
