PRESENTATIONS

03 A. Summer Programs

Assistant Superintendent Moran started this evening's presentation with a reminder of the District's Mission, Global Learning Competencies, the Strategic Coherence Plan and Goals and the Definition of Deep Learning. Among the other items discussed in this evening were; Summer programs enrollment 579 students last summer to 327 students this summer(down strategically), ESY Program (student with IEP's), enrollment breakdown by program and year, all BPS students and summer students overall; Enrichment/Credit Recovery Programs - ELL Students, free/ reduced students (are we targeting the students that we intended to), Aimsweb data Kindergarten and Grade 1 (test selection, data criteria)

including student performance, elementary summer school survey (anecdotal), the survey questions included; population, do you belong in this class, how positive is the energy, how interesting does your teacher make it in class, if it's hard how likely are you to keep trying (overall positive perception), WIS summer school survey (anecdotal), the survey questions included; population, positivity, do you belong, not in class how often do you talk about ideas from class, how interesting do your teachers make it during class, how likely are you to read your book when not in summer school, summer reading celebration (elementary - Read to Grow Bookmobile), WIS Math Assessment (anecdotal and quantified data) prioritizing standards in the coming year, WIS grade level math data (we found that in each area there was a level where we could strengthen their understanding and an area where they needed additional support) and BHS academic data (Credit Recovery) including 55 students invited and 42 students registered (overall great success, 3 students did not receive credit due to attendance).

04 B. Overview of Teaching & Learning 2024-2025

Among the items discussed in this evening's presentation were;

- October Student Learning Update and School Goals Elementary (SBA data, possible Fall Aimsweb data, elementary principles will discuss goals and strategy maps)
- November Student Learning Update and School Goals Secondary (Fall Aimsweb data for grades 5-8, Spring SBA data for grades 5-8, Spring NGSS results for grades 5,8 and 9, SAT results and Advance Placement testing results)
- December BHS Pathways and Guidance Naviance (new college and career pathways post graduation, based on student interests) and New Course Proposals (based on ECE/UCONN courses)
- January Leader in Me WIS (based on Social and Emotional and student voice) and K-4 Math Textbook Selection Process (committee members, different resources looked into, what teachers found when they were piloting the resources)
- February HMH (new core ELA resource) into Reading Update (teaching with integrity)
- March Student Learning Update for K-8 (Winter Aimsweb data and possible PSA data from BHS)
- April STEM Update (5th through 12th grade)and Safe School Climate Update (revised School Climate Plan facilitated by Dianne Dadio)
- May Student Celebrations: Class of '25 Future Plans (post secondary plans for BHS seniors)
