MINUTES

The Board of Finance held a regular meeting on Monday, September 30, 2024 was called to order by Chairman Mooney at 7:30 p.m. at Fire Headquarters, 45 North Main Street, Branford, CT. The meeting was available for remote public viewing via BCTV (Comcast Channel 20) and Facebook Live.

Board members seated were Chairman Joseph Mooney, Deborah Conklin, Harry DiAdamo, Pamela DeLise and Jeffrey Vailette. Victor Cassella was absent. Also present were First Selectman James Cosgrove, Jim Finch, Finance Director, Kathryn LaBanca, Assistant Finance Director and Lisa Arpin, Town Clerk. RTM reps in attendance were Maryann Amore, Adrian Bonenberger, Tracy Everson and Alisa Waterman. Also present were Brian Koczak, Blaize Levitan, Thomas Mahoney, Robert Massey, Alex Palluzzi and Dr. Christopher Tranberg.

- 1. The minutes of the August 26, 2024 meeting were approved unanimously by motion from Mr. Vailette, seconded by Mr. DiAdamo.
- 2. Citizen's Communication -- There was no public comment.
- 3. The Board heard a presentation of the FY2023 Audit results by Vanessa Rossitto, Principal at CliftonLarsonAllen LLP. Ms. Rossitto reviewed the terms of engagement, executive summary, highlights of the financial statements, federal single audit, state single audit, the management letter, summarized the governance communication from CLA to the BOF, and review of upcoming GASB announcements.

A clean and unmodified opinion over the 6/30/23 financial statements; the best opinion to receive, meaning everything is fairly stated and in accordance with accounting standards. There was an internal finding regarding the timing of the financial reporting close. Comments in the management letter were discussed. The federal single audit did not have any compliance findings, and a clean opinion was issued. There was a small internal control finding, which was a common finding in many clients. It is recommended the town

implement a procedure that when a contractor is hired under a federal grant, to check the website to ensure the contractor is not suspended or barred. The State single audit did not have any compliance findings-four programs were tested. The increase in long-term liabilities from \$131M to \$143M was due to the net pension liability for the State of CT pension plan-increased by \$20M. The net position from FY22 to FY23 increased from \$206M to \$219M--positive results from 2022 to 2023 on a full accrual basis. The general fund returned \$9M to fund balance increasing it to \$47.5M to \$56.6M at 6/30/23. Capital projects fund balance decreased \$1M but still has a healthy fund balance at \$19.3M. The ARPA fund grant revenues equaled expenditures of \$2.183M so there is no fund balance in this fund. The non-major governmental funds had an increase in fund balance of \$983,000. Overall, all governmental funds of the town fund balance increased \$9M from FY22 to FY23.

Financial highlights indicated revenues were \$10.76M over the FY23 budget, and expenditures were \$2.91 under budget. Regarding long-term liabilities, the net pension liability was \$53.89M an increase of \$20.4M. There were small decreases to the Police pension plan net liability of \$500,000, and Fire pension net liability decreased by \$100,000. The net OPEB assets are greater than the liability; the asset increased \$6.6M and the asset is \$13.8M at 6/30/23. There were no management disagreements. GASB transparency standards implemented for year 2024 were covered (Statement 99 & 100.) GASB Statement 101 & 102 were mentioned for 2025 and GASB Statement 103 for 2026.

The management letter comments covered four items:

- BOE bank reconciliations noted were not performed since December 2022. It took time to reconcile the statements and ensure moving forward that they are done monthly.
- The reports coming from tax collector system did not reconcile to the general ledger which took significant time for the finance department to reconcile them. It is recommended that the Town review and strengthen reconciliation procedures at the least quarterly, but preferably monthly.
- Best practices regarding cybersecurity were recommended to institute an annual vulnerability and security risk assessment
- Recommend institute a formal internal fraud tip hotline
- 4. Finance Director Jim Finch discussed the winding down of ARPA appropriations which is a common theme on these items, as well as to reduce future bonding authorizations via Contingency appropriations. ARPA dollars need to be allocated by 12/31/24 through a PO or a contract and must be spent by 2026. Chairman Mooney read the following transfers and resolutions for consideration:

ARPA Fund FY2025 Resolution and Transfer

Resolved: That the Board of Finance recommends to the RTM an increase in the ARPA fund budget from \$7,710,500 to \$8,185,500. This appropriation will be used to fund a grant to the Corcoran Sundquist Post 83 of the American Legion.

This transfer appropriates the grants while also transferring funds to the fueling station project.

Motion to approve the resolution and transfers was made by Mr. Vailette, seconded by Mr. DiAdamo. Vote unanimous.

5. The Board heard a presentation by Fire Chief Tom Mahoney, Assistant Fire Chief Brian Koczak, and Commissioner Robert Massey regarding appropriations for the Fire Department. Chief Mahoney reminded the Board that during the FY2025 budget presentation, the BOF approved the lump sum into Contingency, and this transfer will place the dollars into the appropriate line items in preparation for the hiring process of 16 new EMT's. There was a robust application process (109 applicants) and interviews are starting this week with an expected hire date of November 1st.

Finance Director Finch reported the FY2024 Contingency fund would be \$352,022 net of the approval of tonight's items. Chief Mahoney talked about the inflationary environment for new apparatus, comparing the Engine 5 purchase in 2018 at \$535,000; that same engine today is \$1.1 million, and delivery times were one year and are now up to 3 years lead time. See meeting handout entitled "Vehicle Replacement Plan" with a Firematic Supply Company, Inc. contract (for Engine 9) hoping to be put into place in November. Jim Finch gave input on the conceptual plan. Chairman Mooney requested an updated inventory of all the vehicles vs replacement timing.

Mr. DiAdamo made the motion to approve the transfer, seconded by Mr. Vailette. The vote was unanimous.

RESOLVED: That the Board of Finance recommends to the RTM the approval of \$500,000 from Contingency to the Fire Apparatus Fund for FY2024.

Chief Mahoney noted that during the remounting of the patient compartment box on the ambulance, items were found that needed to be addressed regarding the supports on the new frame due to winter weather wear and tear.

He extended his appreciation for this historic move to a new staffing model, and couldn't have done it without the Board's cooperation, as it will be a vast improvement in our ability to serve the entire community.

Mr. Vailette made the motion to approve the transfer, seconded by Ms. Conklin with a unanimous vote of approval.

RESOLVED: That the Board of Finance recommends to the RTM the approval of \$1,320,481 from Contingency to the Fire Services budget for FY2025.

The management of six cards for the Town will be handled by Finance with appropriate approvals in place. Blaize Levitan, Chief Operating Officer of Branford Board of Education noted BOE currently has one P-card and will be moving to 3 purchasing cards managed by his office. BOE cards will be for the Central office, Technology and one for programs at the high school. Chairman Mooney offered Mr. Levitan good luck on the audit presentation recommendations, and Mr. Levitan expressed thanks to Kathryn Labanca and the Town for the excellent partnership with BOE.

Resolved: That the Board of Finance authorizes the Finance Director to enter into an agreement with Bank of America to provide p-card services to the Town of Branford with a maximum spending limit of \$90,000. This program will be administered by the Finance Department.

Resolved: That the Board of Finance authorizes the Chief Operating Officer of the Board of Education to enter into an agreement with Bank of America to provide p-card services to the Branford Board of Education with a maximum spending limit of \$50,000. This program will be administered by the BOE Finance Department.

Chairman Mooney asked for approval of the two resolutions and Mr. Vailette made the motion to approve both resolutions, seconded by Ms. Conklin with a unanimous vote of approval.

10. The Board heard a transfer request from Town Clerk Arpin for the FY2024 Legislative budget. She noted an overage of \$570 in the Town Clerk budget offset the transfer request.

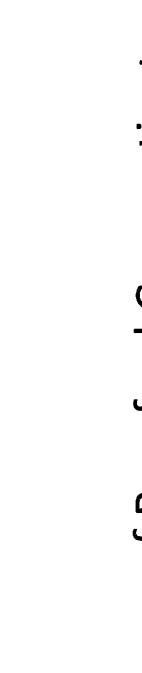

ARPA and Contingency Appropriations

I am writing on behalf of the First Selectman for appropriations from the ARPA Fund to fulfill previously identified needs combined with my thoughts on using ARPA and general fund dollars to reduce future bonding requirements.

Previously Identified Needs:

Last May the Board heard a presentation from the Corcoran Sundquist Post 83 of the American Legion. Additionally, the board received a letter from the Branford Interfaith Housing Corporation. Both organizations identified how their financial constraints prevented them from making improvements to their facilities. As of the time of this writing the Branford Interfaith Housing Corporation has asked us to put their request on hold as they explore other avenues.

Reduce Future Bonding:

As you may recall upon receiving the ARPA award, the board expressed a preference for using the bulk of the allocation to fund items related to government services which for practical purposes translates to items in the town's operating budget and pay as you go capital items. While the fueling station project could be considered a large pay as you go capital project or a small, bonded project I believe the proposed funding approach combining ARPA, general fund and bond proceeds (attached) is reflective of the project's size and components. Finally, it is worth noting that in the past we have used bond authorizations to allow a project to move forward while ultimately funding the project with non-debt resources. This approach was used for the Indian Neck Fire Station.

Other Considerations:

Please note that ARPA dollars must be obligated by December 31, 2024. As a result, eligible expenditures must either be spent by December 31, 2024, or

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obligated by contract or purchase order. Branford has until December 31, 2026, to fully expend all previously obligated dollars.

Required Actions:

If the Board concurs with the recommendations to fund these requests, then the following actions are required:

- Amend (increase) the ARPA fund budget and create appropriations in the fund.
- Amend the revenue sources originally appropriated for the fueling station project.

The ambulance fund experienced a shortfall in FY 2024 as the final costs for the ambulance remount exceeded the original purchase order. This transfer will cover the overage with a small margin going forward.

Should the town consider using bond authorizations in the future to acquire large apparatus purchases?

Over the last two decades the town typically funded large apparatus purchases through sinking funds. These sinking funds accumulated dollars to make future purchases in accordance with a vehicle replacement schedule. This arrangement worked reasonably well when prices were stable and product lead times were comparatively short. Unfortunately, we are in an environment in which prices are escalating and lead times are expanding.

As a result, I am recommending the use of bond authorizations for apparatus purchases in the near future. Since the town's bond authorizations are written in a way that combines an appropriation (legal authority to spend) with the authority to borrow it allows the town to enter contracts with manufacturers prior to having the dollars (cash) in place to meet the payment obligations. Under this scenario appropriations would still flow into the apparatus fund and reduce the actual bonding required and the longer lead time allows for more appropriations.

CONTRACT

THIS AGREEMENT, made by Firematic Supply Co., Inc., East Yaphank, NY, first party and the Town of Branford Connecticut, by its authorized representative, second party.

WITNESSETH:

First. The said first party hereby agrees to furnish the apparatus and equipment according to the specifications referenced in Bid# 1598 and to deliver the same as hereinafter provided.

Second. The first party agrees that all material and workmanship in and about said apparatus and equipment shall comply with said specifications. In the event there is any conflict between Customer Specifications and the Firematic Proposal, the Firematic Proposal will prevail. The standard Pierce Manufacturing Warranty will apply.

Third. This contract for fire apparatus conforms with all Federal Department of Transportation (DOT) rules and regulations in effect at the time of contract signing, and with all National Fire Protection Association (NFPA) guidelines for Automotive Fire Apparatus as published at the time of contract signing, except as modified by customer specifications. Any increased cost incurred by first party because of future changes in or additions to said DOT or NFPA standards will be passed along to the customer as an addition to the price set forth below, upon written approval of the second party.

Fourth. The said apparatus and equipment shall be ready for delivery from Appleton WI within about 46 to 50 Months after receipt and acceptance of this contract at the first party's office at East Yaphank, New York. Delays due to strikes, failures to obtain chassis, materials or other causes beyond its control not preventing, and shall deliver to said party of the second part at Norwalk Connecticut.

Due to global supply chain constraints, any delivery date contained herein is a good faith estimate as of the date of this order/contract, and merely an approximation based on current information. Delivery updates will be made available, and a final firm delivery date will be provided as soon as possible.

Fifth. A competent serviceman shall upon request, be furnished by first party to demonstrate said apparatus for second party and to give its employees the necessary instructions in the operation and handling of said apparatus.

Sixth. The second party hereby purchases and agrees to pay for said apparatus and equipment, the sum of:

\$ 1,099,386.00 One Million Ninety Nine Thousand Three Hundred Eighty Six Dollars

Payment shall be made directly to first party at its, East Yaphank, New York, office. Under no circumstances shall payment be made to any other party except Firematic Supply Co, Inc.

Any representation that payment is authorized to be made to another party is in violation of this agreement. Net payment is due upon acceptance at the Fire House of the second party.



Payment is due upon delivery and acceptance.

Seventh. In case the second party desires to test the apparatus, such test shall be made within ten (10) days after arrival at destination and a written report of such test forthwith delivered to the first party at its principal office at Rocky Hill Connecticut. If no such test is to be made, or if no such report be made by the second party within ten (10) days after arrival, then said apparatus and equipment shall be considered as fully complying with customers specifications.

Eighth. It is agreed that the apparatus and equipment covered by this contract shall remain the property of the first party, until the entire contract price has been paid.

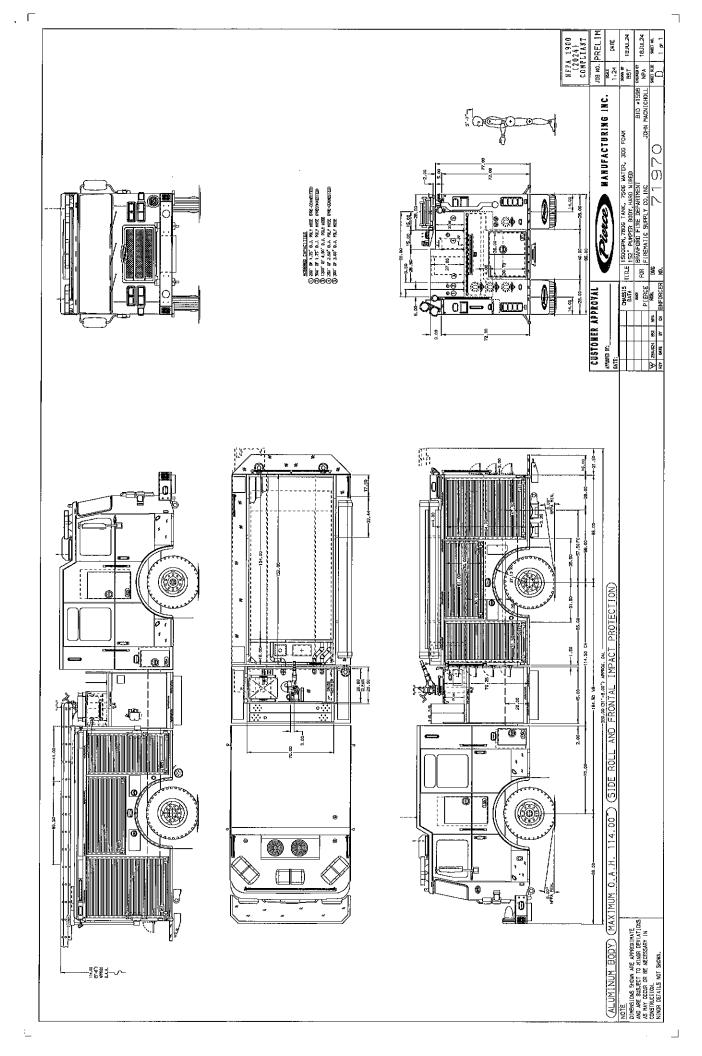

The seller will document any such updated price for the customer's approval before proceeding and provide an option to cancel the order without charge if the updated price isn't accepted.

Closeout Project 18503 Energy Performance Contract (FY 2025)

The second item for your consideration is a request to closeout project 18503 which was initially created six years ago to fund a series of energy conservation measures at the Town and Board of Education. Project 18503 was then amended approximately four years ago to include lighting projects at Branford High School and Veteran's Memorial Park.

This project was funded through bonds, general fund transfers as well as loans and grants from the utility companies. The appropriation as amended for the lighting projects totaled \$6.2 million. We are fortunate that total expenditures were marginally under budget and that revenues were marginally over budget resulting in approximately \$50,000 coming back to the general fund in FY 2025.

We are asking you to consider the following transfer submitted by the Finance Director for the Parks & Recreation Department for the lighting repairs required for Veteran's Memorial Park and Foote Memorial Park.

Foote Park Scope: Excavate a 12" x 270' trench, saw cut concrete areas and remove, and pour new concrete sections at (3,500psi). Apply a broom finish, and back fill trench. Install 2" schedule 40 electrical pipe and clean up. Add two 30 amp, 277 volt feeds, approximately 270 feet from Foote Park main building to the pull box located by the Foote Park welcome sign. Conduit will be installed along the overhang of the rear of the building to the utility room.

Vet's Park Scope: Install new conduit and wire from the main electrical panel in the utility room of the main building to the existing pole lights. Circuits to be run to each area, to include; playground, basketball court, parking lot, tennis courts and walkway. There are a total of 18 pole lights. New conduit and wire will be installed from pole to pole. Conduit to be 1" PVC. Wire to be #10CU THHN. All poles will be properly grounded. All existing wiring to poles will be removed, or cut and abandoned in existing conduits. All trenching and saw cutting will be provided with asphalt and concrete repairs. Sand will be provided for all trenches.

I am writing to request the approval of two resolutions which will allow the Town and BOE to implement a purchasing card program (p-card) through Bank of America.

Background

At the Board of Finance meeting in February 2006 a resolution was approved allowing the Finance Department to apply for credit cards for certain employees. This program was originally provided by Wachovia Bank but has subsequently been administered through Bank of America and over the years there have been supplemental resolutions increasing the limits of certain cards while adding cards for additional personnel. While the use of credit cards has, at times, had its challenges overall the use of credit cards has proved beneficial to the town through cost savings, ease of making emergency purchases and recurring annual charges for online services.

Our office was contacted by Bank of America a few months ago informing us they are discontinuing the credit card program for municipalities and moving their existing clients with multiple cards to their p-card platform. At the time, I reached out to several banking institutions and was surprised to learn that most banks will not enter into credit card arrangements with municipalities that need multiple cards. Jim and I discussed alternatives and decided it was more beneficial to the town to request approval to implement the program.

P-Card Implementation

The major difference between individual credit cards and p-cards is that an individual card is person and credit limit specific whereas the P-Card program is customizable and administered by the town and BOE's Finance Departments. The resolutions before you seek approval to enter into the program with an aggregate spending cap of \$90,000 for

the Town and \$50,000 for the Board of Education as they are required to have their own agreement due to the fact that they have a different FEIN from the town.

If approved, purchases with p-cards, like with individual credit cards, will continue to follow the same purchasing procedures that have been in place for years. Therefore, I have prepared the following resolutions for your consideration.

Resolved: The Board of Finance authorizes the Finance Director to enter into an agreement with Bank of America to provide p-card services to the Town of Branford with a maximum spending limit of \$90,000. This program will be administered by the Finance Department.

Resolved: The Board of Finance authorizes the Chief Operating Officer to enter into an agreement with Bank of America to provide p-card services to the Branford Board of Education with a maximum spending limit of \$50,000. This program will be administered by the BOE Finance Department.
