We will table at Branford and EH dinners on the green in the summer; Tabling at the Earth Day celebration on the Branford green resulted in 11 new applications; Foam stress-reduction balls were ordered as give-away for tabling; Upcoming meeting with EH re: establishing EH CEC; 1/8 page ads were published in The Sound in four consecutive issues (to be repeated in Sept); HeatSmart banner was delivered to Public Works, to be hung over Main St on May 29 for two weeks
- 3. SHuttner: EV Chargers are being installed at the Community House, the Stony Creek Firehouse and on Main street. EMahler made it happen urgently given Eversource incentives end 5/22.
- 4. DLaich: The recreation department has interest in obtaining an EV. Donna will follow up.
- **5. GAmes: Buildings:** High energy use at the renovated animal shelter is due to omission of controls, will be corrected.

The PD project has been funded and is proceeding, including Eversource incentives. John Hoefferle found structural drawings which are being assessed, it appears there may be structural capacity to increase the roof insulation and support solar (In addition to the solar to be incorporated on the parking canopy).

The Public Building Commission is taking a proactive role during the design phases of projects.
