1. DRabin: HeatSmart Dan reported achieving the goals of the Community
Partnership Initiative. The East Haven one year project began in Nov 2023 and is
thus completed, while the Branford work started Jan 2024 and will run through
the end of the year. Energize CT will only be funding Round 3 HES-IE projects for
distressed communities and those with Environmental Justice zones, so
Branford will not be eligible. Dan also reported the HeatSmart project in other
SCRCOG communities.
