# 5. Education Budget and Administrative Update from the BPS Administration

Dr. Tranberg, Blaize Levitan (virtual), and Peter Berdon participated in the conversation. A brief overview of new programs and goals for improvements to the Branford Education System was provided to the committee. The full day tuition based pre-school program is popular and running at almost full capacity. Please check the BPS website to learn how you can participate in exciting ahappening this month.

Dr. Tranberg's original ask was a 6.8% increase. The BOE reduced the initial request to a 5.8%. When factoring in Excess Cost Reimbursement for special education, the impact to the taxpayer will be a 4.6% increase.
