**Receive update on I&I progress:** A draft report from Sarah Bucci at AECOM was submitted providing updates. Next steps were discussed.

**Sewer Access Applications**

- a. 85-101 So. Main St (52 new residential)

A motion was made to approve the capacity study for the potential new 52 residential units by Chris DiAdamo and seconded by Mike Tamsin. Motion carried unanimously.

**To consider and if appropriate approve the removal of the sewer utility fees**

- a. Unit 14 at 26 No. Main St

A motion was made for the Wastewater Pollution Control to approve the removal of the \$1017.20 billing error for trailer unit 14 per the Tax Collectors office by Justin Rossetti and seconded by Chris DiAdamo. Motion carried unanimously.

**Wastewater Treatment plant Reports:**

Collection System Manager Dan LaBanca reviewed the Wastewater Treatment numbers:

In March 2025, sewage processed 3.7 average mgd, septic waste processed 1,060,455 gallons and septic receiving revenues was \$71,050.50.

**Plant Operations:**

Replaced variable frequency drive for number one Sodium Hypochlorite pump. The number 2 main influent pump variable frequency drive was taken out of service and sent back to manufacturer for warranty work. A main breaker component at the treatment plant was replaced. The plant process is running in the range of DEEP requirements.

**Collection system:**

Clean and inspected all pump stations weekly. Pumped out all holding tanks weekly. Topped off generator fuel tanks at various pump stations. Replaced generator and transfer switch at Maple Pump Station. Replaced one manhole frame on Rose St and one on Rogers St. Smoke testing project with Savy & Sons has been completed. Pumped out Animal shelter, Transfer station, and police department. C J Fucci construction Inc repaired two sections of pipe on main St. Installed new Pump and floats at Watch hill Rd Pump Station. Camera 7,557 feet of sewer line and jetted 11,564 feet of sewer line.

**Town Engineer Report:**

Rose Hill and Pent Road Sewer design will move forward. Waiting for an updated design and cost estimate from a consultant, then we will need to discuss next steps.
